For those looking for a well-managed camping break in a natural environment, Avon Tyrrell offers the perfect venue for families and organised groups, with a mixture of woodland and lakeside pitches.

Open 1 March - 1 November.

Lakeside Camping

Located at the bottom of our 65-acre site to the south of the main house, our lakeside camping area offers great views of the lake and plenty of open space to enjoy.

This is a dog free zone, but we can accommodate motorhomes, caravans and tents, with a combination of electric hook ups and non-electric pitches available.

Forest Camping

Our Forest Camping is split into 5 sections, most of which are dog friendly. While most of the forest area is only suitable for tents, we do have a few hard standing pitches available with electric hook ups for motorhomes.

Escape Camping

Just off the main lakeside field, our Escape Camping pitches provide electric for tents only and is the perfect, secluded space for groups.

Facilities

Electric hook ups - pre booking essential (must provide own hook up cable)

Toilets and hot shower facilities

Sheltered washing up facilities

Easy access to drinking water

Adventure play areas and Bouldering Wall (suitable for under 8 years)

Fixed communal BBQ areas

BBQ's

BBQ's and fire pits are permitted on site, but must be kept off the ground and extinguished after use.

Fixed communal fire pits are located at various locations around the site. These cannot be pre-booked in advance and are available on a first come first served basis.

Facility blocks

Boathouse (Lakeside) - Mixed toilet and shower facilities with family changing cubicles and separate accessible wetroom.

Forest facilities (Forest Camping) - Separate male and female toilet and shower facilities.

Reception Facilities - Mixed toilet and shower facilities and a separate accessible wetroom.



Dogs

We have a number of dog friendly pitches in our forest camping area - these must be booked at the time of booking to ensure you are allocated a pitch in our dog friendly areas.

Dogs must be kept on a lead and owners must dispose of waste in the bins provided.

We DO NOT allow dogs down on the lakeside camping area or around the activity bases.



Important information

You must bring your own camping equipment. This is not provided.

We do not provide electric hook up cables (you must bring your own cable.)

If you are bringing a gazebo, you will need to book and pay for an additional pitch, otherwise you will be asked to take the gazebo down.

This is a family campsite. We do not accept large adult groups.

All groups must have a designated party leader who must be 18+ years.

The ground on site can be hard in places, so we recommend bringing heavy duty pegs.

Group Camping & Packages

We have a number of 2 and 4-man tents that we can pre-pitch for organised groups as part of a camping, activity and catering package.

For large groups, we may be able to provide you with an exclusive space, so please contact in advance.
