

Camping

For those looking for a well-managed camping break in a natural environment, Avon Tyrrell offers the perfect venue for families and organised groups, with a mixture of woodland and lakeside pitches. Our 65-acre site offers plenty of open space to enjoy. Open from 1 March until the 1 November.

Lakeside Camping

Located at the bottom of our site, the lakeside camping area offers great views of the lake. We can accommodate motorhomes, caravans and tents, with a combination of electric hook-ups and non-electric pitches available.

Forest Camping

Our Forest Camping is split into 5 sections, all of which are dog friendly. A few hard-standing pitches are available with electric hook-ups for motorhomes.

Escape Camping

Just off the main lakeside field, our Escape Camping pitches are tents only and is the perfect secluded space for guests.

Tented Village

Our new tented village has 10 pre-pitched tents available from May - July. Each tent sleeps up to 5 and includes camp beds and lights. Electric is available but you must bring your own hook up cable (you can hire or buy one from our shop).

Facility Blocks

Boathouse (Lakeside) - Mixed toilet and shower facilities with family changing cubicles and separate accessible wet room.

Forest Facilities (Forest Camping) - Separate male and female toilet and shower facilities

Reception Facilities - Mixed toilet and shower facilities, and a separate accessible wet room.

Important Information

You must bring your own camping equipment. This is not provided. We do not provide electric hook up cables.

If you are looking to bring a gazebo, it will need to fit within you marked pitch allocation otherwise you will need to book an additional pitch in advance.

Contact our team for pitch sizes.

This is a family campsite, we do not accept large group bookings. All groups must have a designated party leader who must be 18+ years.

The ground can be hard in places, so we recommend bringing heavy duty pegs.

Dogs

We have a number of dog friendly pitches on our site. If you are planning to bring your dog, please let us know at time of booking to ensure we allocate a pitch in our dog friendly area. We DO NOT allow dogs on the lakeside camping area or around the activity bases.

BBQs

BBQs and fire pits are permitted on site, but must be kept off the ground and extinguished after use.

There may be occasions when these are not permitted for safety reasons (during dry spells).
