

Be Outdoor Day Code of Conduct

This document outlines the expectation of behaviour whilst participating in our Be Outdoor Days. Please ensure that if your child has additional needs or triggers, that these are communicated to the team when dropping your child off so we can ensure a fair approach.

Rules to follow

We ask that those attending be respectful to the other children and the Avon Tyrrell staff while attending the day. The basic principles we ask all to follow are;

- Respect the property of Avon Tyrrell and those participating
- Communicate in a kind and respectful manner
- Ensure everyone’s personal space is respected
- Have fun! And allow those around you to do the same.

3 Strike Rule

We have a 3-strike rule on our Be Outdoor Days to ensure that all children have a safe and enjoyable experience.

Strike 1 (Verbal Warning)	Strike 2 (Verbal Warning & Call Home)	Strike 3 (Will be collected)
Issued if they are being unsafe or disruptive because of bad language, not listening, being rude etc.	If they continue to break the rules following strike 1	If they continue to break the rules following 2 strikes
		If they physically harm/threaten/bully another person or are deemed unsafe to others and/or are impact the safety of the sessions.

If strikes are issued, these will be passed on to the parent/guardian when they are collected. Strikes will be carried over for any days they are due to attend within that week but will be wiped clean each Monday. If they have been given 3 strikes and have to be collected, we will discuss how we proceed with the parent/guardian on collection.
